BCCG Organisation

BCCG is a privately-funded, non-profit making membership network organisation, which was found in Cologne in 1919 and in Hamburg in 1921. It was closed down in the early 1930s and was re-established in Cologne/Bonn in 1960. HM Ambassador to Germany is the honorary patron of the Chamber.

Members of the Chamber comprise about 1,000 professionals and companies, of which approximately 10% enjoy the special status "Sustaining Member". In addition to that, a number of members (up to the age of 40) have joined our Young BCCG programme. The network consists of over 3,500 and we also maintain contact with our members in all European British Chambers through COBCOE, the Chamber's umbrella organisation. The BCCG is the largest British Chamber in Europe.
